11	Feeding the 5000	Luke 9:10-17	Bread and fish	Jesus fed lots of people with only 2 fish and a loaf of bread.
12	Transfiguration	Matthew 17:1-3	Shiny mountain	Jesus went up on a mountain and bright light shone everywhere.
13	Jesus sends out the 72	Mark 9:2-10	Arrows	Jesus sent out his followers to tell others about him.
14	Jesus raises Lazarus	John 11:38-44	Lazarus in strips with happy sisters	Jesus brought Lazarus back from the dead and his sisters were surprised and happy.
15	Little children	Matthew 19:13-14	JC with little kids	Jesus loves little children.
16	Zacchaeus	Luke 19:1-9	Jesus looking at Zacchaeus up the tree	Jesus saw Zacchaeus up the tree and came for dinner.
17	Triumphal Entry	John 12:12-16	Donkey and palm branches	The last week of Jesus life started when he rode into Jerusalem on a donkey and everyone shouted, 'Hosanna!'
18	Jesus cries over Jerusalem	Luke 19:41--44	Jesus crying with Jerusalem in background	Jesus cried over Jerusalem because he knew it would be destroyed.
19	Jesus clears the Temple	Luke 19:45-47	Jesus angry with temple in background	Jesus was angry because people were using the Temple to make money instead of to worship God.
20	Jesus anointed at Bethany	Matthew 26:6-13	Perfume bottle and woman	A woman poured perfume on Jesus to get him ready for his

21	Judas agrees to betray Jesus	Matthew 26:14-16	30 pieces of silver	Judas agreed to give Jesus to the bad men who wanted to kill him.
22	Jesus washes the disciples' feet	John 13:3-5, 14-16	Foot and water bowl	Then Jesus and his friends had a special last meal together. Jesus started it by washing the feet of his 12 special friends.
23	Lord's supper – bread	Matthew 26:26	Bread	Jesus took bread and said, 'This will remind you of my body, broken for you.'
24	Lord's supper – wine	Matthew 26:27-28	Wine cup	Jesus took the drink and said, 'This will remind you of my blood poured out for you.'
25	Jesus prays at Gethsemane	Mark 14:33-36	Trees with moon and stars (night)	Jesus prayed at night in the garden.
26	Arrested	Mark 14:43-50	Clubs and swords	Some men came to take Jesus away.
27	Sanhedrin	Mark 14:53-56	Jesus with angry old man	They took Jesus to the elders and told lies about him.
28	Peter denies Jesus	Mark 14:66-72	Rooster	Peter said, 'I do not know Jesus' even though he did, because he was afraid, and then rooster crowed.
29	Pilate	Mark 15: 1-14	Jesus with man with olive crown	The Roman ruler Pilate handed Jesus over to be killed.
30	Robe, crown of thorns	Matthew 27:27-31	Purple robe, crown of thorns	Pilate's men made fun of Jesus with a fancy robe and a crown made of spikes.
31	Simon of Cyrene	Luke 23:26	Black man carrying cross	A man called Simon carried Jesus' cross.
32	Crucifixion	Luke 23:33-34	Hammer and nails	Jesus was nailed to a cross.
33	Dividing clothes	John 19:23-24	Dice and clothes	The soldiers played games to get Jesus' clothes.
34	2 thieves	Luke 23:39-43	3 crosses	One of the men with Jesus made fun of him but the other one trusted him.
35	John and Mary	John 19:25-27	John and Mary	Jesus asked John to look after his mother Mary.
36	My God my God	Matthew 27:45-46	Eclipse / black	Jesus said, 'God why have you forsaken me', which means, 'Where are you God?'
37	Father, into your hands	Luke 23:44-46	JC peaceful face	Jesus said, 'Father, into your hands I commit my spirit', which means, 'I'm dying. Please take care of me God.'
38 (Fri)	Death of Jesus	Matthew 27:50-51	Torn curtain	Jesus died. It was very sad.
39 (Sat)	Jesus is buried	Matthew 27:57-60	Tomb	Jesus was buried in a tomb and a big rock put in front of it.
40(Sun)	Resurrection	Luke 24:1-8	Empty tomb, shining man and bowing women	When the women went to the tomb they discovered Jesus was not there. He was alive!
